


When the sanctuary was built in 1924, Lamb Studios designed and installed the stained glass window depicting Christ as the Good Shepherd. The window is a magnificent example of plated opalescent glass, a technique made famous by Lamb, Tiffany and Lafarge, which employs multiple layers of glass to create shadows, depth and rich color. The Good Shepherd window is in need of immediate restoration to preserve its beauty and integrity and prevent further damage to the valuable art glass.

In early June, Lamb Studios will remove the window to its studio in New Jersey to perform the restoration.

When the Good Shepherd Window is reinstalled in the fall of 2017, it will be rededicated in loving memory of Rev. John H. Meyer. Restoration of the Good Shepherd window will serve as a lasting memorial to Rev. Meyer, reminding us to be grateful for his many years of devoted service to the church and people he loved so much.

Rev. John H. Meyer was pastor of the Community Church of Douglaston from 1972 to 2000, the “good shepherd” who cared for his congregation and community for 28 years.



He passed away on May 9, 2016 at the age of 78.
